

HAZ16 – Food and General Waste Disposal

Waste represents a food source to vermin and will be controlled.

Controls

- a. Waste is kept to a minimum in the kitchens and is stored in lidded bins enclosing a black bag. The bags will be sealed and placed in closed “wheely bins” in the utility area to the rear of the property.**
- b. Food waste is managed in line with Carmarthen County Council policy, stored in sealed brown food waste bucket and transferred to larger green bucket (stored outside). This is primarily used for meat based and cooked vegetable waste. This is subject to weekly collection on Wednesdays. Two buckets maintained, one in commercial kitchen, one in domestic kitchen.**
- c. Uncooked vegetable waste is collected in two white plastic swing bins and composted within Ty Canol Gardens.**
- d. Other non-food, non-recyclable waste in the commercial kitchen is managed via. a washable open black bucket, emptied regularly during the food preparation shift into a black bag and placed in a closed “wheely bin”.**
- e. Dry, clean plastic waste; dry clean paper waste and washed food tins are managed by recycling (HAZ17)**
